

## UpToDate® Anywhere

Westmead Hospital Library is pleased to announce that our subscription to UpToDate has now been extended and enhanced.

UpToDate is one of the major clinical support tools and includes more than 10,500 topics covering general internal medicine and more than 22 specialties; a select drug database and drug interaction tool (in partnership with Lexicomp®); nearly 1,500 patient education topics; more than 28,000 graphics; and links to more than 400,000 references.

The upgrade to **UpToDate Anywhere** now provides clinical answers not only at the point of care from all onsite computers, but, now also allows you to download this app to your mobile and access the resources remotely simply by registering onsite from the Westmead Hospital Library Homepage.

Registration is simple and Library staff are always happy to assist with the process. You will need to renew your registration every 90 days on a work computer but will receive advance notice of this.
