Family Planning NSW provides reproductive and sexual health services. They have experts on contraception, pregnancy options, STIs, sexuality and sexual function, menstruation, menopause, common gynaecological and vaginal problems, cervical screening and breast awareness.

In any one day clinicians listen to, care for, treat and support people from diverse backgrounds who are facing complex and difficult issues relating to their reproductive and sexual health.

When someone visits a family planning clinic, they come to talk about matters that are profoundly personal. The clinicians listen without judgement to each and every story from each and every person and to assist in finding solutions that are right for the individual in their own circumstances.

Free translator services for clinic consultations and a range of translated factsheets into languages other than English are also available.

There are 5 Family Planning clinics situated in Fairfield, Ashfield, Penrith, Newcastle and Dubbo, with some appointments after hours and on Saturday mornings at Ashfield and Fairfield that suit busy working women.
