This would be expected to involve:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participating in the care of medically ill patients • Assessing patients on admission and completing appropriate documentation • Assist in the appropriate ordering and follow-up of investigations • Assist in the co-ordination of consultations with other teams. • Participate in the assessment of psychiatric conditions and act as primary psychiatric medical officer for a limited number of patients. • Participate in ward rounds and multidisciplinary clinical meetings. • Participate in Psycho-Geriatric registrar rounds on C4b • Attend outpatient clinics and home visits. • Provide relief services for Toxicology.
