## RECRUITMENT FACT SHEET FOR APPLICANTS

This document provides information regarding recruitment for advanced training positions in Radiation Oncology, accredited by The Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Radiologists (RANZCR) for the 2019 Clinical Year Requirements for the 2019 period will be advertised in accordance with NSW Health Policy Directive *Recruitment and Selection of Staff of the NSW Health Service- Additional Standards for Junior Medical Officer Annual Recruitment Campaign*. The recruitment process will comply with NSW Health policies for recruitment in the public sector and the principles of equal employment opportunity.

### APPLICATIONS

Applications open on Thursday 19 July 2018 and close on Monday 20 August 2018. Northern NSW and Southern NSW/ACT Networks advertise separately for all networked accredited training positions. You can complete separate application forms for these through the online process on the [NSW Health JMO Recruitment website](#).

### INTERVIEWS

Applicants whom are shortlisted for interview will be contacted via automated email from the JMO Recruitment website. Each selection panel consists of representation from each hospital training site as well as an independent or HR representative. Interviews for both Networks in NSW will be held concurrently on an agreed date between 31 August and 11 September 2018 at The Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Radiologists, Level 9, 51 Druiitt Street, Sydney.

Please ensure that your referees are available to be contacted during the recruitment period, as they may be contacted prior to interview.

### PREFERENCING SITES

Prior to the interview, applicants will be required to preference sites in the Northern and Southern Networks on a form. These will not be accessed by either Network until after all the interviews have been conducted.

Candidates who are successful at interview for both Networks will receive one offer based on interview performance and candidate preference.

It is important to note that all Network positions include a mandatory 12 month rotation requirement (to another site within the Network) before eligibility can be reached to sit the final exam.

### OFFERS

At the end of the interview process, reference checking and preference considerations, Preliminary Offers will be made via automated email from the JMO Recruitment website. All offers will be made by Local Health Districts. Applicants will NOT receive verbal offers. **Please note successful applicants will receive only one offer for a Radiation Oncology position.** Applicants must accept or decline offers within 48 hours of it being sent.
