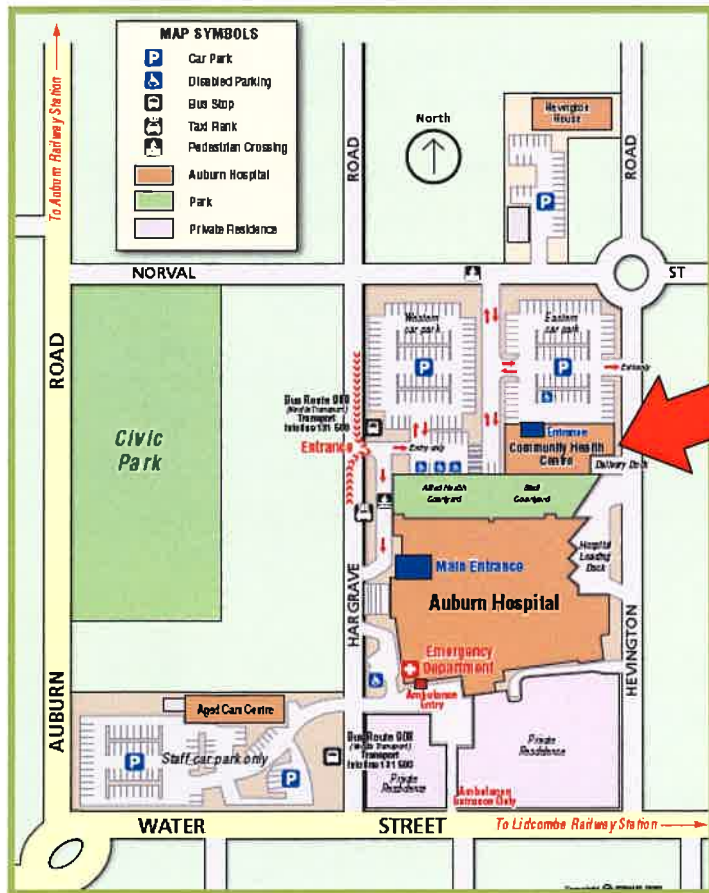

Any child under the age of 5 needing vaccination can
come to our clinics, even if you are not eligible for
Medicare.

Bring your child's Blue Book to each visit

- The Nurses in our clinics are all specially trained in giving vaccines to young children and babies.
- The vaccines given are approved by the government on the Australian Immunisation Schedule.
- We record your child's vaccinations in their Blue Book and also send a copy to The Australian Childhood Immunisation Register.
- Our nurses will ask you a few questions before vaccinating your child and will be happy to answer any questions you may have.
- Immunisation is the safest way to protect your child from diseases. After immunisation, your child is far less likely to catch these diseases if there are cases in the community.

- It is important to have most people in the community immunised as this stops the spread of disease.
