What's happening?

Merrylands Community Health Centre is being renovated by Western Sydney Local Health District (WSLHD). The renovation is part of NSW Health's HealthOne strategy to improve access to general practice and primary care. The aim is to create a stronger primary healthcare system by bringing together GPs, community health and other health professionals in one location.



What will change?

Merrylands Community Health Centre will become a vibrant, integrated "one-stop-shop" for health services, providing more care closer to the community and out of hospital.

Patients will have access to a wide range of services in a new, cutting-edge facility. Fit-for-purpose spaces will maintain and improve patient experience and wellness, and meet the needs of a diverse and growing community. Some changes include:

- An improved waiting and reception area
- New, multi-purpose consult and treatment rooms
- Improved technology to enable greater connectivity between services and support collaborative, multi-disciplinary care.
