



WESTMEAD EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT RELOCATION

The Westmead Emergency Department (ED) will **relocate within the Westmead Health Precinct on Wednesday 17 February.**

 The service will move to the 14-level Central Acute Services Building (CASB), within 500 metres of its former site.

 The CASB is located on Hawkesbury Road, between Westmead Hospital and The Children's Hospital at Westmead (towards the back of the Westmead Institute of Medical Research).

 Patients will be dropped off in front of the new lower-level ED entrance via Hawkesbury Road.



The new Adults' Emergency Department features:

- Improved patient care and safety
- New treatment spaces/equipment
- No returns to the waiting room
- Easier access and drop-off



The new Emergency Department for The Children's Hospital at Westmead is also located in the CASB, accessed via Hawkesbury Road on street level.



Parking for adults' and children's EDs is available via Hawkesbury Road (follow the P5 signs). See the WSLHD website for full map.



The CASB will host several adults' and children's services, including emergency, pharmacy, imaging and state-of-the-art operating suites.
